VENERABLE MOTHER MARY VERONICA OF THE PASSION FOUNDRESS OF THE APOSTOLIC CARMEL



1823-1906

Mother Veronica, nee Sophie Leaves, was born in 1823 in a pious, cultured, English Anglican family. She was gifted with singular talents of mind and heart which were nurtured by sound education and wide experience. Inspite of her mother's strong opposition she embraced the Catholic faith in 1850. God took possession of her heart so powerfully that she first broke off her engagement to a marine officer, whom she loved, and then responded generously to the call to religious life. She entered the Congregation of the Sisters of St.Joseph of the Apparition in 1851, taking the name, Sister Mary Veronica of the Passion.

Mother Veronica was ardent and full of zeal to work for the mission in India, when she was sent to found a house of the Congregation at Calicut in 1862. She responded to an inner call and under the guidance of Fr. Marie Ephrem O.C.D discovered her vocation to found a Third Order Regular of active Carmelites to serve the need of faith-formation through education of young girls of west coast of India. After receiving the required permission from Rome, Mother Veronica painfully left her Congregation to enter the Carmel of Pau, France in 1867. On completion of her novitiate

and first profession, she left Pau and founded the Apostolic Carmel at Bayonne, France in 1868 after facing many hardships in her relentless search for God's will.

The first group of Apostolic Carmelites arrived in India in 1870 and were established in the Diocese of Mangalore. Unfavourable circumstance obliged Mother Veronica to close the convent at Bayonne in 1873, after which she re-entered the Carmel of Pau as a Cloistered Carmelite. After a period of 12 years in a new foundation at Bethlehem, Mother Veronica returned to Pau in 1887. Her life of loving surrender to God in challenging circumstances culminated in her holy death in 1906. She was declared venerable on 9th July 2014 by Holy Father Pope Francis.

THE APOSTOLIC CARMEL CONGREGATION

The little seed sown in the heart of Mother Veronica over 150 years ago has now grown into a mighty tree, its branches spreading over the length and breadth of India and Sri Lanka, Pakistan, Kuwait, Kenya, Italy, Bahrain, Tanzania and France. Rooted in the contemplative spirit of Carmel and nourished by the life of prayer and missionary zeal, the charism of the Apostolic Carmel lives on undiminished in its original freshness and dynamism through its active apostolate of Education and other apostolic ministries. The congregation has more than 210 educational institutions spread over 9 countries.

THE APOSTOLIC CARMEL VISION OF EDUCATION

The education imparted by the Apostolic Carmel is geared towards the total development of a person by instilling in them Gospel values and forming responsible citizens equipped to work for the transformation of society.

GENERAL INFORMATION

A group of Apostolic Carmel Sisters came to Nilambur and began Fatimagiri convent on April 26, 1971 in Chandakunnu–

Nilambur, aside the Calicut Ootty road, on an expanse of ten acres. Two months later, on first June, the school started with 6 pupils on roll, to realize the dream of our foundress to empower the people of the locality through the mission of education. For the 27 years, the school imparted specialized instruction in the medium of English at the lower primary stage, with classes I to IV and kindergarten.

In 1999 the school was upgraded to a High School and switched over to C.B.S.E. Syllabus. In March the first batch of students appeared for AISSE examination. Ever since, the students bring laurels to the school with cent percent results. In 2011 the School was again upgraded to a Senior Secondary School.

OBJECTIVE OF OUR SCHOOL

Inspired by the spirit of our Foundress that God's love is all sufficing, we the sisters of the Apostolic Carmel aim at giving a Christian education directed to the integral development of the young.

GENERAL DIRECTIVES

- 1. Students must attend school on all working days and be punctual.
- 2. Every student must carry with him / her daily the school
- 3. Children must be in their respective class rooms as they come.
- 4. As English is the medium of instruction, students are to speak only English in the Campus.
- 5. Clean and well pressed School uniform must be worn on all working days and at all school functions. The Student who is sloppily dressed is liable to be de-merited.
- 6. All the students are free to wear jersey during games period.

- 7. Students should obey the teachers and school authorities in all matters and are expected to follow any instruction that may be given by the school authorities.
- 8. Politeness and courtesy are expected from the students. Every student is urged to maintain in his/her manner and conduct high moral and spiritual standards set by the school.
- 9. Any reported or observed objectionable conduct of the pupil inside or even outside the campus will invite disciplinary action.
- 10. Every student must take part in physical education and other co-curricular activities unless rendered medically unfit or exempted by the Principal.
- 11. All the Students must return after vacation on the re-opening day. Those return late after the holidays must present a medical certificate before they are admitted to class. Absence of more than five class days renders the pupil liable to be struck off the rolls.
- 12. Care must be taken of all school property and no pupil should scribble or spoil the desks or chairs or damage any school furniture. Any damage made will be made good by the one who does it. No pupil should bring blades or any sharp instruments to the school.
- 13. The school cannot hold itself responsible for books, money, clothes and other articles that are lost. It is not advisable for children to have money or valuable articles with them. *Gold ornaments, Smart watches and Mobile phones are not allowed.*
- 14. For entries in report cards and diaries, intended for parents as well as for notices to parents, a student must obtain his parent's or guardian's acknowledgment by signature within three days.

- 15. The Principal has the right to suspend any pupil without having to state any reason provided that she is satisfied that such a step is necessary in the interest of the school.
- 16. Misbehaviour like teasing other children, irregular attendance, disobedience or disrespect to teachers, habitual idleness, stealing etc. obstruct intellectual and moral growth and thereby development of personality. Hence such behaviour calls for correction and disciplinary action if necessary.
- 17. Books, tiffin carrier, umbrella etc., and other stationery items should bear the name of the owner. The school undertakes no responsibility for the loss of things or money.
- 18. The students should behave in a refined manner wherever they go. They should always remember that the school is judged by their conduct.
- 19. Each class will be responsible for looking after all their class properties.
- 20. The School accepts no responsibility if there is failure in wearing school uniform, or in bringing books to class or in getting signatures of parents on remarks written by teachers on achievement record and the pupil is asked to return home during class hours. Even late comers may be sent home.
- 21. Absentees, without prior permission, on the re-opening days, after Onam, Pooja, Christmas and summer holidays will be taken seriously. The usual leave letters will not be accepted. The parent has to bring the child in person and explain the reason for the absence to the Principal without whose written permission the child will not be admitted to any class.
- 22. Pupils should be in the school before the first bell. All should attend the Assembly in the morning, before the classes begin.

- Late comers will not be allowed to enter the class without the Principal's permission.
- 23. A pupil who persists in being irregular and indifferent and who defaults frequently in submitting exercises and in showing due respect to the teachers is likely to be sent away forfeiting all the fee that has been paid.
- 24. If a student is late to school for 5 consecutive days, he / she will be de-merited.
- 25. Ist and 3rd Saturday will be working days.
- 26. During the school hours no student is allowed to leave the school premises without the permission of the principal. Once you are in the school premises no parent should approach the school for leave except on emergency needs.
- 27. Good behavior and good manners are expected at all times. Use of bad language, reading of obscene literature and unruly behavior are forbidden.
- 28. Honesty is expected of every pupil, if a pupil finds something that does not belong to her/him, he/she should inform the office authorities about the articles found and leave the same in the office. Pupils who have lost the articles may enquire about them in the school office.
- 29. No money collection is to be made in school without the Permission of the Principal.
- 30. Stuednts are not allowed to give gifts both to members of the Staff ro to one another, on any occasion.
- 31. Inorder to avaid the use of plastic in the Campus students are not allowed to bring sweets on their birthdays. Nor are the students allowed to bring any Plastic materials to the school

LABORATARY RULES

- 1. Observe perfect silence.
- 2. Follow the instructions of the teachers and laboratory assistant.
- 3. Be responsible for any breakage or loss of articles used.
- 4. Report every breakage or loss immediately to the teacher incharge.

LIBRARY RULES

- 1. Strict discipline and silence are to be observed in the library.
- 2. A student can borrow one book at a time.
- 3. Library books will be issued and returned during library periods only.
- 4. Marking, underlining, cutting and erasing or tearing pages of the books are strictly prohibited.
- 5. Text books, reference books, journals and periodicals are to be read in the library.
- 6. The librarian may recall a book at anytime in case of urgency.
- 7. Library books are to be returned at least one week before the vacations.
- 8. A "No due" certificate for each student is to be obtained from the librarian at the time of taking T.C. from the school.

ADMISSION AND WITHDRAWALS

- 1. The School is open for admission to both boys and girls irrespective of caste, creed and social status.
- 2. While seeking admission the following documents are to be produced.

- 3. Admission is done on written application in the prescribed form duly filled in, and signed by father/mother
- 4 TC will be issued to the applicant only after a week and after the payment of all dues.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE OF ABSENCE

- 1. The application for leave should be sent in the Parent eye.
- 2. In case of absence without leave, the student on returning to school must have the reason of absence certified very briefly by his/her parents in the school diary on the page set aside for it
- 3. A student requiring leave for any part of a day on account of sudden illness or such unavoidable circumstances should obtain permission of the class teacher and principal before leaving the school.
- 4. Continuous absence for 15 days from school without permission will lead to the removal of the student's name from the school register. In such case, re-admission will be done only after payment of re-admission fee of Rs.1000/-Re-admission cannot be claimed as a matter of right. The school authorities will have full discretion in this matter.
- 5. No child suffering from any contagious or infectious disease shall be permitted to attend the classes.

ASSESSMENTS AND PROMOTION

1. Promotion will be granted or denied on the basis of marks/ grades obtained in the assessments for all subjects as well as co-curricular activities.
